Youth Guidelines

- 1 adult chaperone for every 5 youth ages 12 – 18.
- Adult chaperones are encouraged to raise funds, but it is not mandatory.
- Children under 12 should be with parent.
- Registration is due at the event - or before!
- At registration, we need list of youth attending and list of adult chaperones. Bracelets will be given to all participants.
- Participants are asked to raise at least \$100.
- Youth are encouraged to collect donations and secure in envelope; mail \$ with registration or bring sealed to the event.
- Checks need to be made payable to Family Promise of Monmouth County, and note in the memo line, "Cardboard Box City".
- Donation may also be made online by credit card.
- Plan to get your own boxes – Try any local appliance store.
- Prizes will be awarded for best decorated, most \$ raised, etc.
- Set-up is from 6:00 – 7:00 p.m. Friday; please keep your group together!
- No alcoholic beverages, electronic devices or pets allowed.
- We are providing soup and bread for dinner from 7 – 8 p.m.
- "Parade of Boxes" will be open to the public at 7 p.m.
- "There will be individual Speakers".
- "There will be live entertainment"
- Please advise all youth to be respectful of others.
- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. – 6 a.m. and will be enforced.
- Security will be provided during quiet hours.
- A light breakfast will be served from 6 - 7:30 a.m.
- Take down is from 6 – 8 a.m.
- Please have all your groups leave their site sparkling clean!
